Topic: Impact of Cold War Policies on American Society in the 1950's

a. Three tiered quick writes

I Write an obituary for either President Truman or Gen. MacArthur. Must include the most important 5 facts that you feel should be know about him at his death.

ii. After studying several examples, students will create an advertisement for a product that was new and/or improved in the 1950's. Should also include a drawing of the product, and should be created as a poster.

iii. Students will create a propaganda poster either for or against the building and use of the Hydrogen Bomb during the 1950's. You will also need to have a written paragraph to go along with your poster.

Clearly builds a persuasive argument.

6-7 Strong Essays

The thesis shows a persuasive take on how American society was impacted by gov't policies during the Cold War.

The body of the paper shows some analysis.

Identifies at least 2 specific examples from each of the 3 areas of comparison, may contain minor errors.

Somewhat builds a persuasive argument.

4-5 Mixed Essays

The thesis shows a moderately persuasive statement on how American society was impacted by gov't policies during the Cold War.

The body of the paper shows only a discussion style of the topic.

Identifies at least 6 specific examples overall for at least 2 areas of comparison, may contain significant errors.

Makes only a vague argument.

2-3 Weak Essays

The thesis is only stated in an expository manner.

The body offers only a general discussion of American society during the Cold War. Identifies at least 3 specific examples overall, may contain major errors. Simply presents information.

0-1 Weaker Essays

The thesis does not address the prompt, is missing or simply restates the prompt. The body offers only vague discussion. Identifies less than 3 examples, may contain major errors. Makes no argument.
